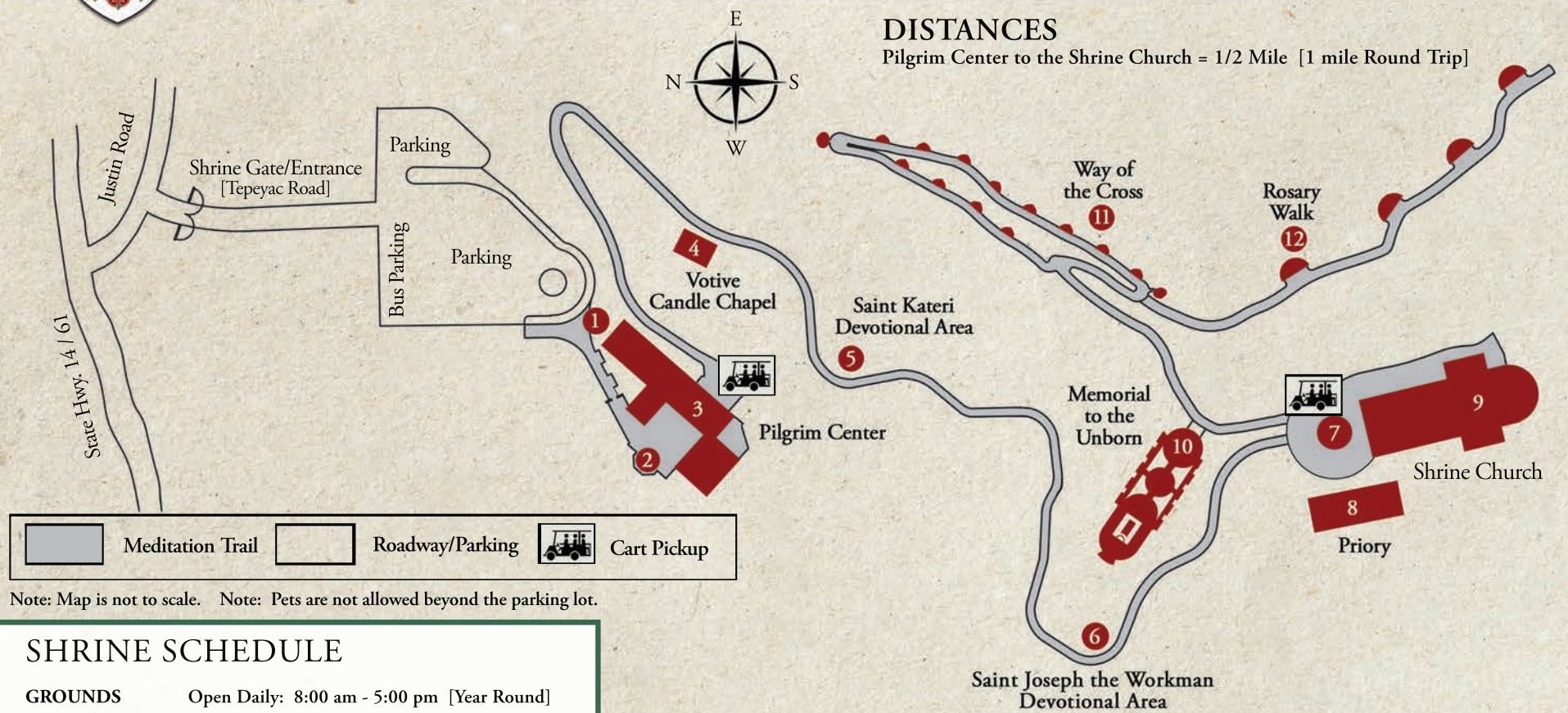

WELCOME TO THE SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE



1. SAINT JUAN DIEGO STATUE

Near the Shrine entrance, this statue depicts Saint Juan Diego opening his Tilma to display the miraculous image of the Virgin Mary. This statue was a gift from Norberto Cardinal Rivera Carrera, the Archbishop and Primate Emeritus of Mexico.



2. OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE STATUE

This sculpture of Our Lady of Guadalupe greets pilgrims as they enter the Pilgrim Center plaza. Our Lady's gaze depicts a loving mother looking upon and praying for her earthly children.



3. PILGRIM CENTER

This beautiful building is home to our pilgrim information desk, gift shop, book store, café, and administrative office. It also leads to the start of the meditation trail. *(Cart shuttles are available here).*



4. MOTHER OF GOOD COUNSEL VOTIVE CANDLE CHAPEL

Stop here to light one of 700 votive candles burning for the prayer intentions of pilgrims. Beautiful stained glass windows inside depict major Marian apparition sites from around the world.



5. SAINT KATERI TEKAKWITHA STATUE

Commissioned with the help of the Native American community, this sculpture depicts Saint Kateri kneeling and gazing upon a simple wooden cross. Saint Kateri (named after Saint Catherine) is also known today as the "Lily of the Mohawks."



6. SAINT JOSEPH THE WORKMAN STATUE

Depicting a humble scene in Nazareth, this bronze sculpture emphasizes the fatherly virtues of strength and tenderness. Our Lady, seeing Jesus holding lumber in the shape of a cross, is reminded of the Prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:25-35).



7. SAINT JUAN DIEGO AND BISHOP JUAN DE ZUMARRAGA STATUE

This statue captures in time the very moment of the Miracle of the Tilma. As Juan Diego unfolds his cloak or tilma to deliver the Castilian Roses from Our Lady, the miraculous image appears.



8. PRIORY

Norbertine Fathers reside in the priory, living a common life of liturgical prayer, while also providing spiritual assistance and pastoral care for pilgrims. *(This is a private residence).*



9. SHRINE CHURCH

The Church is the spiritual center of the Shrine. Holy Mass, Confessions, Adoration, and Benediction are offered here daily. *(A phone is available in the Narthex to request a cart shuttle).*



10. MEMORIAL TO THE UNBORN

This area is dedicated to babies who were lost before birth. "It eloquently expresses the message of Our Lady of Guadalupe: God's all merciful love toward all of His children from the moment of their conception." - Raymond Leo Cardinal Burke



11. WAY OF THE CROSS

Here you are invited to walk with Jesus in His final hours on His journey to Calvary. Beautiful bronze sculptures located at each station assist you in meditating on Our Lord's Passion.



12. ROSARY WALK

Beautiful works of art assist you as you pray the rosary and meditate upon major events in the life of Jesus and Mary. The *joyful, luminous, sorrowful, and glorious mysteries* are each featured on their own alcove.
